— COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS —

- Saw action in 34 games (24 starts) during his four-year (2020-23) career at Marshall, posting 514 carries for 2,831 yards (5.5 avg.) and 39 TDs, while adding 76 receptions 565 yards and 3 TDs...Also tallied a 97-yard KOR...Accumulated the bulk of his stats, including all 39 rushing TDs, over the last three years of his collegiate career (2021-23) after the pandemic-shortened season in 2020...The 39 rushing scores marked the nation's third most from 2021-23...Surpassed 100 rushing yards in 11 career contests, while posting 14 games with multiple ground scores
- Started all 12 games in which he saw action for Marshall in 2023, posting 212 carries for 1,135 yards (5.4 avg.) and 15 TDs, while adding 28 receptions for 213 yards and 1 TD...Notched six games with multiple rushing TDs, while his 15 ground scores tied for the nation's 11th most...Also surpassed 100 rushing yards in four contests and posted an FBS-high 7 gains of at least 50 yards (6 rushing & 1 receiving)...Earned second-team All-Sun Belt Conference honors
- Saw action in three games with Marshall after missing the first 10 games of the 2022 season with a knee injury...Totaled 47 carries for 273 yards (5.8 avg.) and 1 TD, while adding 2 receptions for 10 yards and 1 TD...Rushed for at least 75 yards in all three appearances...Earned Myrtle Beach Bowl MVP honors for his performance
- In 2021, appeared in 13 games (12 starts) for the Thundering Herd, tallying career highs in most major rushing categories, including attempts (250), yards (1,401) and TDs (23), on 5.6 yards per carry...Also added career highs in receptions (46) and receiving yards (342), notching 1 TD through the air, as well as a 97-yard KOR-TD...His 23 ground scores tied (RB Tyler Allgeier) for the most in the nation, while his 1,401 rushing yards placed 10th...Totaled six 100-yard rushing outings and eight games with multiple rushing TDs...Earned FWAA Freshman All-American and first-team All-Conference USA honors
- Made six appearances in Marshall's pandemic-shortened 2020 campaign, posting 5 rushes for 22 yards and 4 KORs for 76 yards

— PERSONAL —

- Started boxing at 4-years old and playing football at the age of 6...Also played basketball and lacrosse during his childhood
- Decided to focus on boxing and skip participation in football during his sophomore and junior years of HS...During that time, competed in junior boxing tournaments all over the region...Due to lack of varsity film, received very few college offers
- Credits his boxing background for the physical and mental toughness he showcases on the field...His footwork, hand-eye coordination and balance were also polished through boxing

"Rasheen Ali is an explosive guy. He runs hard, and he finishes his runs. He catches the ball well, he can run routes, and he's a good pass protector. At the Senior Bowl, he was a guy that I noticed very quickly. He got hurt, but during the week at practice, he was very, very explosive, and I think we all took note. He's an interesting kid. He's got a great background, and he's going to be a good player for us."

2023: (MARSHALL – 12/12)

- Started all 12 games in which he saw action, posting 212 carries for 1,135 yards (5.4 avg.) and 15 TDs, while adding 28 receptions for 213 yards and 1 TD...Notched six games with multiple rushing TDs, while his 15 ground scores tied for the nation's 11th most...Also surpassed 100 rushing yards in four contests and posted an FBS-high 7 gains of at least 50 yards (6 rushing & 1 receiving)...Earned second-team All-Sun Belt Conference honors
- Posted 9 rushes for 92 yards (10.2 avg.), including a season-long 64-yard dash, and 1 TD in the season finale vs. UTSA...His 10.2 yards per carry marked a career high
- Notched 165 rushing yards, including a 55-yard scamper, and tied his season high with 3 TDs on 24 carries (6.9 avg.) in the win vs. Georgia Southern
- Tallied 19 attempts for 103 yards (5.4 avg.) and 2 TDs, while adding a career-high 71 receiving yards and 1 TD on 4 receptions, at Georgia State...His 65-yard grab marked the longest reception of his career
- Registered 28 carries for 79 yards and 2 TDs in the win vs. Old Dominion, marking his fourth-consecutive game with multiple rushing scores
- Notched a season-high 174 rushing yards, while adding 2 TD ground scores, on 27 carries (6.4 avg.) in the win vs. Virginia Tech

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- Tallied 85 rushing yards and 3 rushing TDs on 18 carries, while adding 4 receptions for 45 yards, in the win at East Carolina
- Recorded 137 rushing yards and 2 TDs on 18 carries (7.6 avg.) in the win vs. Albany

2022: (MARSHALL – 3/0)

- Saw action in three games after missing the first 10 games of the season with a knee injury... Totaled 47 carries for 273 yards (5.8 avg.) and 1 TD, while adding 2 receptions for 10 yards and 1 TD... Rushed for at least 75 yards in all three appearances
- Posted 15 carries for 92 yards (6.1 avg.), including a season-long 38-yard rush, and 1 TD, en route to earning game MVP honors, in the Myrtle Beach Bowl victory at UConn
- Registered 102 yards on 16 carries (6.4 avg.), while adding a 5-yard TD grab, in the win vs. Georgia State

2021: (MARSHALL – 13/12)

- Appeared in 13 games (12 starts), tallying career highs in most major rushing categories, including attempts (250), yards (1,401) and TDs (23), on 5.6 yards per carry... Also added career highs in receptions (46) and receiving yards (342), notching 1 TD through the air, as well as a 97-yard KOR-TD... His 23 ground scores tied (RB Tyler Allgeier) for the most in the nation, while his 1,401 rushing yards placed 10th... Totaled six 100-yard rushing outings and eight games with multiple rushing TDs... Earned FWAA Freshman All-American and first-team All-Conference USA honors
- Posted 160 yards, including a season-long 63-yard gain, and 3 TDs on 20 carries (8.0 avg.) in the New Orleans Bowl vs. Louisiana
- Tallied 3 TDs and a career-high 203 yards, including a 59-yarder, on 23 carries (8.8 avg.) in the win at Charlotte... His 8.8 yards per carry marked a season high

- Registered 18 carries for 90 yards (5.0 avg.) and 2 TDs, marking his third-straight multi-TD rushing game, while adding a season-high 70 receiving yards on 6 receptions, in the win at Florida Atlantic
- Recorded 133 yards and 2 TDs on 26 carries (5.1 avg.) in the win at Florida International
- Posted 109 yards and 2 TDs on 20 attempts (5.5 avg.), while adding a season-long 50-yard grab in the win at North Texas
- Registered 19 carries for 113 yards (5.9 avg.) and 3 TDs, while adding 6 receptions for 48 yards, at Middle Tennessee... It marked his third-straight game with a rushing score
- Tallied 17 rushes for 83 yards and 1 TD, while adding a career-long 97-yard KOR-TD, at Appalachian State
- Notched 24 carries for 189 yards (7.9 avg.) and 3 TDs vs. East Carolina
- Totaled 8 carries for 45 rushing yards (5.6 avg.), while adding 55 receiving yards and 1 TD grab on a career-high 9 receptions, in the win vs. NC Central
- Posted 59 yards and a career-high 4 rushing TDs on 14 carries in the opening-game victory at Navy

2020: (MARSHALL – 6/0)

- Made six appearances in the pandemic-shortened season, posting 5 rushes for 22 yards and 4 KORs for 76 yards
- Totaled 4 KORs for 76 yards, including a 27-yarder, vs. Rice

— HIGH SCHOOL —

- Prepped at Shaker Heights (Ohio) HS, playing football as a freshman and returning to star on the team as a senior... Decided to forgo his sophomore and junior years on the gridiron, shifting his focus to boxing
- In six games played as a senior (2019), tallied 1,300 rushing yards and 15 rushing TDs
